Know all men by these presents; That, whereas, on the 2nd day of August, A.D. 1904, a mortgage was executed by Aggie Norfer, nee Roberts, to C. E. T., said mortgage having been filed on the 5th day of August A.D. 1904 and File No. 8260, in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio recorder at Wagoner, Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$61.00, and whereas, said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full.

Now, in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to me in hand paid by said Aggie Norfer, nee Roberts. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claimed and set over, and by these presents, do hereby grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said Aggie Norfer, nee Roberts her heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the incidents and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Aggie Norfer, nee Roberts, her heirs and assigns, and to their proper heirs, benefit and behoof, forever, free, clear, and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
