Know All Men by These Presents; that, to-wit, on the 24th day of February A.D. 1906, a mortgage was executed by Henrietta Carlile to R. A. Cravens for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to-wit: $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ and $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 14 East, said mortgage having been filed for record on the 1st day of March A.D. 1906, and recorded in Book 14 at Page 41 in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio recorder at Claremore, Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$95.00 and, whereas, said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full;

Now, in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to me in hand paid by said Henrietta Carlile (now Hailey) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claimed and set over, and by these presents do hereby grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said Henrietta Carlile (now Hailey) her heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage. To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Henrietta Carlile (now Hailey) her heirs and assigns, and to their proper use, benefit and behoof, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
