I, Robert Grayson, on oath state that I am a duly enrolled citizen of the Creek Nation, Indian Territory; that I am the father of Walter Grayson, who is also a citizen of the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, and on the freedman roll; that the East 1/4 of the Ranch east 1/4 of section 4, Township 14, North, Range 14 East in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory was allotted to said Walter Grayson as part of his allotment, and that he has received an allotment deed therefor; that about six or eight months after the birth of said Walter Grayson, I made an entry in a bill of the fact and date of his birth. I made the entry on the 6th day of May, 1885; that it is barely possible that that may not have been the exact day of his birth, but I am positive that he was born either in May or June 1885. I still have the bill with the entry of his birth therein that I made as above mentioned, and that said entry was made within a few months after his birth.
