The Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, a Commission, heretofore appointed under the Act of Congress approved May 31, 1900 (31 Stats. 221), and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stats. 716), ratified by the Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, has appraised, the late in the town of Owasso, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory; and

Whereas, the plan of said town was approved, by the Secretary of the Interior on the 26th day of March, 1904, and was duly placed on file; and

Whereas, said Commission has appraised all of the town late included in said plan at their true value, exceeding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

Whereas, the said Commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Samuel K. Eueland, who has paid One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars, the full amount of the purchase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee, Indian Territory, and is, therefore, entitled to a patent:

Now, Therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid, Act of the Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell, and convey unto the said Samuel K. Eueland his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, and interest of the Cherokee Nation, aforesaid, in and to Lots numbered 6 and 7 in Block numbered 26 in the Town of Owasso, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and according to the plan thereof on file as aforesaid.

In witness whereof, I, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand, and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date herein-after shown - Date June 28th, 1905.
