Oil and Gas Lease

This Lease, made between John Bush, sole heir at law of Silbber Bush, deceased party of the first part, and Ethel Davis party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that in consideration of Eighty \$80.00 dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part hereby agrees with the party of the second part: That he shall have the exclusive right for Twenty-one years, from this date to enter upon and operate for Oil or Gas on all of that certain tract of land in Creek Nation, Indian Territory, described as follows: South East Quarter, of Section Twenty-seven, Township nineteen, Range Thirteen, acres 160. (Sole heir at law of Silbber Bush dec'd) containing 160 acres, more or less, upon the following terms and conditions: Second party shall deliver in tanks at the wells of the first party, without cash, one tenth of all Oil produced on these premises, and pay the market price in cash for the same if the first party shall so desire, and said second party to pay all damages of any kind that may arise by reason of their operations thereon. If Oil or Gas is found in paying quantities in any well drilled, the privilege of operating shall continue as long as Oil or Gas shall be produced in paying quantities, and when abandoned for such purposes this grant shall cease and shall no longer be binding on either party. If gas is found on the above described land, the party of the first part to have the use of the same for domestic purposes free. The second party reserves the right to remove all machinery and fixtures placed thereon by them. This lease shall be come absolutely null and void after one year unless the second party shall elect from year to year to continue this lease by paying or depositing to the credit of the first party an annual rental of One \$100.00 Dollars at City National Bank Bank of Tulsa, Ind. Ter. said rental to be deposited on or before the 29th day of December each year.

It is also understood and agreed by both parties to this contract, that the second party shall have the right to sell and transfer, or assign her interests in this contract or lease or any portion of the same.

It is understood by and between the first and second parties to this agreement that all conditions between the first and second parties herein shall extend to their heirs, executors and assigns.
