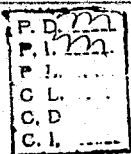

Release of Mortgage.

Know all men by these Presents: That, whereas, on the 26th day of March, A.D. 1904, a mortgage was executed by R. S. Brumfield, to James H. Gaddy for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to-wit: Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, in block 23 in the town of Broken Arrow, I. T. said mortgage having been filed for record on the 27th day of April A.D. 1904 and recorded in book 79m. at page 200 in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and ex-officio recorder at Wagoner, Indian Territory; and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$250.00, and, whereas, said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full.

Now, in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to me in hand paid by said R. S. Brumfield, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quit claim and set over, and by these presents do hereby grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said R. S. Brumfield his heirs and assigns, all his right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said R. S. Brumfield, his heirs and assigns, and to their proper use, benefit and behoof; forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
