

and demand sufficient gas for all domestic purposes, and the party of the second part shall have the right to use said gas from said well or wells in drilling other wells upon said lands and operating the same.

That said party of the second part, upon the expiration of this contract as the fulfillment of the same, shall have and not remove any buildings or improvements erected thereon during said term by the said party of the second part, but said buildings and improvements shall remain a part of said lands and become the property of the owner of the land as a part of the conservation and the contract in addition to the other covenants herein specified, excepting all tools, boilers, boiler houses, pump houses, pumpjacks and buildings and pits, tanks, engines and machinery and the casing of all dry or wet holes and shall remain the property of the said party of the second part, who may remove them at any time before the expiration of sixty days from the termination of this contract; that he will not permit any nuisance to be maintained on the premises under his control; that he will not use such premises for any other purpose than that authorized in this contract; and that before abandoning any well, he will securely plug the same so as to substantially shut off all oil and gas therefrom and leaving no gas.

All conditions of this agreement shall extend to the heirs, assigns and assigns of the parties hereto.
