

Deed of Release.



I know all men by these presents; That the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa, Ind. Ter., for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred 00/100 Dollars, to it paid by Mary W. Yeager & P. J. Yeager does hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Mary W. Yeager & P. J. Yeager and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit; all of Lot Four (4) in Block Eight Eighteen (18) in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, as the same appears on the official plat of said town.

This deed being made to release the claim of a certain Mortgage dated February 28th, 1906, and recorded March 2nd 1906, 190 - at 9 W. M. in Book V. at Page 490 of the records of mortgages at Sapulpa, Ind. Ter.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII. of the by-laws of said Company, as follows:

"The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business" (corporate seal)
