Lugus Perryman, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says; that he is 68 years of age, a resident of Tulsa, Indian Territory, and a member of the Creek Tribe of Indians, of which he was the chief for a number of years; that he was well acquainted with Noccha Scott a Creek citizen, opposite roll number 6873, during her life time; that she died on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1899, as widow, leaving her two sons, Andy and Sunday Scott, also Creek citizens, opposite roll numbers 3966 and 6872 respectively; that Andy Scott and Nocca Perryman were married on August 18, 1897; that she was born of this marriage three children, Ida Scott, opposite roll number 9423, who died October 2, 1901; Lou Scott, opposite roll number 3968, who died May 9, 1900; and Nancy Scott, not enrolled, who died at the age of eight months on June 2, 1903; that Andy Scott departed this life on January 3, 1903.

This affiant further states that all of the descendants herein mentioned, except the said child Nancy, died in possession of allotments in the Creek Nation or were entitled to allotments which passed fall to their heirs at law.

This affiant further states that Sunday Scott, herein mentioned, is the only living blood relative of any of the descendents herein mentioned, and that Nocca Perryman Scott, now Nocca Scott Burgess, is the only wife of the said Andy Scott, deceased.
