## Release Deed.

Henry W. Perryman.

Whereas Henry W. Perryman and Gertrude Perryman, his wife did on February 1, 1906, by their mortgage deed of that date, convey and mortgage to Walter F. Decatur certain property therein described to secure the payment on certain promissory note dated February 1, 1906, for the sum of \$2500.00, due August 1, 1906, which said mortgage deed was filed for record, at the recorder's office at Sapulpa on February 3, 1906, and is duly recorded in Record "L" page 517;

And Whereas, The said Henry W. Perryman has fully paid and discharged the note and indebtedness described herein secured by said mortgage deed, and are entitled to full release thereof.

Now therefore the undersigned Walter F. Decatur, the mortgagor and legal owner of the indebtedness secured by said mortgage deed, do hereby convey, remise, release and quit claim unto the said Henry W. Perryman, and Gertrude Perryman, their heirs and assigns the property described in said mortgage deed as follows: To wit: North 1/2 of Lot 11 (6); Block 181 City of Sulphur, Western District, Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the said described property, free, clear and discharged of the like and encumbrance of said mortgage deed.
