Quit-Claim Deed.

Snow v. Men By These Presents: That we, J. C. Paulus and Dora E. Paulus (his wife) of Talala I.T., for and in consideration of Fifty Two and 50/100 Dollars, (\$52.50), to me in hand paid by Rasie Rogers of Talala I.T. the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby convey, demise, release, and forever quit-claim, unto the said Rasie Rogers, and her heirs all that tract or parcel of land situate in the Cherokee Nation, Northern District, Indian Territory, and bounded and described as follows, viz: south one half of south West one quarter of North West one quarter of section 15 Township 23 Range 14, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

To have and to hold the above released premises to the said Rasie Rogers, and her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to her use and behoof forever.

And I, the said J. C. Paulus for my heirs, executors, and administrators do covenant with the said Rasie Rogers, her heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under him, but against none other.

And for the consideration aforesaid, and for divers other good and valuable considerations, I Dora E. Paulus, wife of said J. C. Paulus, do hereby release and quit-claim unto the said Rasie Rogers her heirs and assigns all my rights, claims or possibilities of dower, in or out of the aforesaid premises.
