Deed of Release.

Whereas, the debt and interest described on a certain mortgage executed by Robert J. Epperson and wife, Charlotte Epperson on the 13th day of August, 1906, to John M. Lehman, covering the following land and property, to-wit:

A part of lots nos. 2 and 3 in block no. 58, in the city of Lucas, Western Judicial District of Indian Territory, said part of said lots being more particularly described as follows: a plot of ground 76 by 150 feet having a frontage of 150 feet on Cheyenne Avenue and a uniform depth of 76 feet adjoining North First Street, 76 feet to a line which is parallel thereto and 150 feet north-westerly thereof;

Together with all the improvements, buildings and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining consisting of one corrugated iron cotton ^{storage} house, one frame cotton and storage house, one corrugated iron gin house, one frame office building and all machinery in said buildings, on said lots situated including the cotton gin plant thereof, the same being the gin plant of the Lucas Cotton Gin Co. a firm composed of said Robert J. Epperson, alone, consisting among other things, three seventy saw Sumner Sucker Gins with Murray cleaners and feeders, double hop revolving cotton press, Corlies engine sixty horse power, tubular boiler eighty horse power, belts, pulleys, shafts and all other appurtenances belonging to said gin outfit given to secure \$750⁰⁰ and interest has been paid in full by C. C. Hultquist of Coweta, and Term. and said mortgage is satisfied, now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, I, the undersigned mortgagee in said mortgage, do hereby acknowledge satisfaction in full of said mortgage, and release said property from the lien therein described, and hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey said property to Robert J. Epperson and his heirs and assigns free from claim of said mortgage.
