

Rental Contract.

This Agreement, made and entered into this the 11th day of March, 1907, by and between Harriett Jones, Party of the first Part and John H. Crutchfield, Party of the second Part.

Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the second part, the party of the first part this day and by these presents does demise and let to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns for agricultural and grazing purposes for the term of five years from the date hereof the following described land, to wit: The north 1/4 of northeast 1/4 of northeast 1/4 and the southeast 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of section 19, Township 22, Range 13, containing 30 acres, more or less, according to the Government Survey thereof.

In consideration of the use of said tract of land for the terms stated, the party of the second part hereby agrees to pay party of the first part the sum of \$50.00, the receipt whereof is hereby duly acknowledged; it is also agreed by and between the parties herein that the party of the second part shall put a good substantial fence around said tract of land, and to keep same in good condition.
