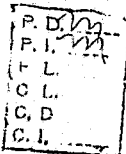

Know all men by these presents, That, I Annie F. Skidmore of Osage Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred Dollars, \$2500.00 in hand paid by L. Price and W.O. Dickinson, receipt of same being hereby acknowledged, Do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said L. Price and W.O. Dickinson, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following Lands lying in the Cherokee Nation, Western District, of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North east quarter of the south west quarter of the south east quarter of section thirty six (36) Township twenty (20) north, Range Twelve (12) East, Containing Ten acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said L. Price and W.O. Dickinson and unto their heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with the said L. Price and W.O. Dickinson that I will forever warrant and defend the title to the said Lands against all claims whatever.
