Know all men by these presents:

Green, his wife and Francis O'Green, Jr. and Edna D. Green his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, as hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company and unto its successors and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, town;

The West ten acres of Lot Eleven (11) in Section Eighteen (18) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company and unto its successors and assigns forever, with all appurtenances therunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And we, Sallie C. Hopkins, wife of the said James C. Hopkins; Frances K. LeCrone, wife of the said George M. LeCrone; Florence A. Green, wife of the said Francis O'Green, Sr. and Edna D. Green, wife of the said Francis O'Green, Jr., for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said The Prairie Oil and Gas Company all our rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
