Affidavit.

I, Mary Jane Hodge, hereby make affidavit that my full and correct name is Mary Jane Hodge; that I sometimes write my name Mary J. Hodge; that I was allotted the East half of the south west Quarter and the south west Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section 5, Township 19, North, Range 13 East, patent therefor being approved to Mary Jane Hodge by the Secretary of the Interior August 21st, 1903; that I had restrictions removed upon the alienation of my allotment (except homestead) by Thomas Ryan, Acting Secretary of the Interior, December 7th, 1905, my name being given in said removal of restrictions as Mary Jane Hodge; that on July 7th, 1906, I made a warranty deed of the aforesaid premises to J. M. Hall and J. M. Gillette, my name being written in said deed Mary J. Hodge; that on November 7th, 1906 I made a deed of correction for the same land and to the same parties above named, my name being given in said deed as Mary J. Hodge; that my name was written Mary J. Hodge in the above named deeds through inadvertence, and that it should have been written Mary Jane Hodge; and finally that Mary Jane Hodge and Mary J. Hodge are one and the same person.
