Affidavit.

I, Mary Jane Stodge, hereby make affidavit that my full and correct name is Mary Jane Stodge; that I sometimes write my name Mary J. Stodge; that I was allotted the East half of the South West Quarter and the South West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section 5, Township 19, North, Range 13 East, patent therefor being approved to Mary Jane Stodge by the Secretary of the Interior August 21st, 1903; that I had restrictions removed upon the alienation of my allotment (except homestead) by Thos. Ryan, Acting Secretary of the Interior, December 7th, 1905, my name being given in said removal of restrictions as Mary Jane Stodge; that on July 1st, 1906, I made a warranty deed of the aforesaid premises to J. M. Hall and J. M. Gillette, my name being written in said deed Mary J. Stodge; that on November 7th, 1906 I made a deed of correction for the same land and to the same parties above named, my name being given in said deed as Mary J. Stodge; that my name was written Mary J. Stodge in the above named deeds through inadvertence, and that it should have been written Mary Jane Stodge; and finally that Mary Jane Stodge and Mary J. Stodge are one and the same person.
