Deed of Release.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That Mr. Mary J. Hodges and Alvin L. Hodges, her husband, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars in hand paid, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto T. C. Giddings and, unto his heirs and assigns forever the following lands, lying in the Creek Nation, Western District, Indian Territory, to wit: Block 100 (10), Section (12) and Township (14) in the Highlands Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed is made in release of a mortgage given by J. M. Hall and J. M. Gillette to the grantors on the tenth day of July, 1906 and is a release only as to the blocks indicated.
