Giddings and unto his heirs and assigns forever the following lands, lying in the Creek Nation, Western District, Indian Territory, to wit; Blacke one (1) and Eight (8) in the Highlands addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed is made in release of a mortgage given by J. W. Hall and C. M. Gillette to the grantors on the tenth day of July, 1906 and is as release only as to the blocks indicated.
