Schedule of Separate Property.

Know all men by these presents; That I, Della Harris, wife
of Charles L. Harris, of Collinsville, Indian Territory, do hereby
schedule the following described property as my own sole
and separate property, to wit:

One agricultural lease given to Thomas J. Parris, for a
period of five years on the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the
SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 22,
North, Range 13 East, also one agricultural lease given
by Jesse H. Parris, for a period of three years, on the W $\frac{1}{2}$
of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 22 North, Range 13 East.

Two mule colts, one year old, one horse mule and one mare
mule, One cow four years old branded (C-O) on right hip, Two
heifer calves, no brands. One gray filly two years old, no
brands. All farm implements on said lease, consisting of corn
planter, two cultivators, one harrow, one sulky, 16 inch plow, one
14 inch walking plow, one corn grinder, one corn sheller, one
mower and rake, one sweep rake, Two sets double harness,
