

The Muscogee (Creek) Nation,

Indian Territory.

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting:

Whereas, By the act of Congress approved March 3d, (3d Stat., 861), aforesaid ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, it was provided that all lands of the Muscogee (Creek) Tribe of Indians, in Indian Territory, except as herein provided, should be allotted among the citizens of said Tribe by the United States Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes so as to give each an equal share of the whole, in value, as nearly as may be; and

Whereas, It was provided by said act of Congress that if a member of said tribe has died before receiving his allotment of land, the same, to which he would have entitled, if living, shall descend to his heirs and his allotted land distributed to them; and

Whereas, the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes has found that Sarah Johnson, a citizen of said tribe, is now dead, and said Commission has certified that the land heretofore allotted has been allotted to the heirs of the said Sarah Johnson.

Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid act of Congress of the United States, have enacted, and conveged, and by these presents ingest and convey, unto the said heirs of Sarah Johnson, deceased, all right, title, and interest, of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation and of all other citizens of said nation in and to the following described land, viz: Lots 9 and 10 less

6.58 acres occupied as right of way by the A.U. & W.R.R. 1/2 sec. 7; Lots 1 and 2 less 6.67 acres occupied as right of way by the A.U. & W.R.R., the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.C. 1/4, and the N.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4, the N.W. 1/4 of the N.C. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of sec. 8, Twp. 1891, and R. 11 E., and the S. 1/2 acre of the S. 20 acres of Lot 4 of sec. 8, Twp. 1891, and R. 11 E., and the S. 1/2 acre of the S. 20 acres of Lot 4 of sec. 5, Twp. 1891, and R. 12 E., of the Indian Reserve mentioned, in Indian Territory, containing One Hundred and Twenty, and 8/100 (120.81) acres more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof subject, however, to the provisions of said act of Congress and to the provisions of the act of Congress approved June 3d, 1902 (3d Stat., 550).

In witness whereof I, the Principal Chief of the Muscogee Creek Nation have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said nation to be affixed this 30th day of August, in D. 1901.
