Special Warranty Deed.

This instrument, made, executed and delivered this 18 day of March, 1887,
by and between Hullette F. Aby and Grace M. Aby, his wife, of Indian Territory, parties of the first part; and Henry Steinberger, trustee, party
of the second part.

Whereas I, the first party in consideration of the sum of Sixty-five & 75th Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the first parties have granted, bargained sold and conveyed, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the second party, his heirs, and assigns, the following described real property, lying and situate in the town of Skiatook, Cherokee Nation, Western District of Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Seven (7) Eight (8) Nine (9), Ten (10) in Block Thirty-five (35) and Lot Eight (8), in Block Thirty-two (32) as shown by the recorded plat, together with the fixtures, furniture and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining.

To have and to hold the same unto the second party his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said first party hereby covenant and agree with the said second party that at the execution and delivery hereof, the first party are the owners of the above described premises, free and clear of any encumbrance whatsoever, and will furnish warrant and defend the title to the said real property in and to the second party, his heirs and assigns, against all claims or acts of the first party and those of all persons claiming by, through and under them.

And I, Grace M. Aby, wife of the said Hullette F. Aby, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry Steinberger, trustee, all my rights of ownership and homestead in and to said lands.
