J. C. Hamilton

Articles of agreement made and entered into by and between
H. A. Shaker, party of the first part, and J. C. Hamilton, party of the
second part, both of Lucas, Indian Territory, this 19th day of April A. D.,
1907; Witnesseth:

That the first party, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars made by the second party, have herein agreed to sell unto the
party of the second part on July 19th 1907, and to convey the same
unto second party by a good and sufficient bill of sale, the following
described household goods located in the dwelling house at the northeast
corner of Denver and Third Streets (South) of Lucas, Indian Ter., to-wit:

One (1) iron bedstead, painted light blue and trimmed with brass corner
knobs and top rails; one (1) iron bedstead, painted light green and with no
brass trimmings; one gilded iron bedstead with very little brass trimmings;
one iron bedstead, painted white with brass trimmings; three light, black
coil bed springs; one heavy, black coil bed spring; one (1) cotton top bed
mattress, striped red, yellow blue and white; three (3) cotton top, bed
mattresses striped blue and white; one (1) brown, ingrain woolen rug,
12 ft by 12 ft; one (1) green ingrain, woolen rug, 9 ft by 12 ft; one (1) red,
woolen, ingrain rug 9 feet by 12 ft; 15 yds of blue and white floor matting
15 yds green and white floor matting; two (2) angle burner, closed, round
gas heaters; one (1) small, square, open front gas heater; one (1) small,
closed front, square parlor gas heater with no nickel trimmings;
three (3) straight back, wood seated, oak dining chairs; two (2) small,
straight back, cane seated rockers; one small, straight back, leather
seated rocker; one (1) large, wood seated, straight back bed room chair
(oak); one (1) plain, oak stained, pine top kitchen table; two oak stands
with square top 20 in. by 20 in. and with small under shelf and with
beaded legs; five (5) pair of lace curtains; four (4) dark green window
shades (plain); four (4) dark green window shades with fringe at bottoms;
two (2) white porcelain water pitchers; one (1) small white porcelain
water pitcher; two (2) white porcelain wash bowls; two (2) white por-
celain soap pans; fifteen (15) yards of Milton velvet Brussels stair carpet
green, brown and red colors and small figured; one (1) Milton velvet Brussels
hall carpet, same color and design as the stair carpet just mentioned,
8 ft by 15 ft with border; one (1) solid piece of linoleum 13 ft by
12 ft, with red, white and green colors and with small, square figures;
one (1) small, oak hall tree with round standard and wooden pegs at
