Under the provisions of the act of Congress, approved July 1, 1902, (32, Stat. 716), you have the right to purchase the above described lots in the town named at the proper per cent of the appraised value thereof, as indicated.

The first payment of ten (10) per centum of the amount due for each lot must be made within sixty days from the date of service of this notice; the second payment of fifteen (15) per centum additional within four months thereafter, and the remainder of the purchase money in three equal annual installments.

All of such payments must be made to the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Muskogee, Indian Territory.

If said payments are not made within the time specified, the property will be subject to sale at public auction to the highest bidder.
