Deed of Dedication

To
The Public

Know all Men By These Presents:

That Emma Drew and C. C. Drew, her husband, hereby dedicate to public use for streets, the following described tracts of ground to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the southeast quarter (4) of the southeast quarter (4) of the northwest quarter (4) of section twelve (12), township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east, thence south six hundred sixty-two (662) feet, thence east thirty (30) feet, thence north six hundred sixty-two (662) feet, thence west thirty (30) feet to point of beginning. Also beginning three hundred (300) feet east of the northwest corner of said subdivision thence south six hundred sixty-two feet (662), thence east sixty (60) feet, thence north six hundred sixty-two feet (662), thence west sixty (60) feet to point of beginning.

Also in said subdivision, beginning at the northeast corner, thence south six hundred sixty-two (662) feet, thence west thirty-two (32) feet, thence north six hundred sixty-two feet (662), thence east thirty-two (32) feet to point of beginning. Also in said subdivision, at a point three hundred and two feet (302) south of the northeast corner, thence west six hundred sixty-two (662) feet, thence south sixty (60) feet, thence east six hundred sixty-two (662) feet, thence north to point of beginning.

That all of said streets are of the free consent and desire of the owners hereby dedicated to and for the use of the public, the same being dedicated to the public as part of the consideration for the purchase price by W. C. Campbell of the property adjacent thereto and evidenced by a deed thereon and of even date herewith.
