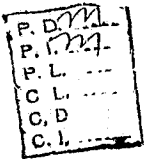

To Have and to hold the same unto the said Elisha D. Deeds, his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging, And the said W.W. Gillespie hereby covenants with the said Elisha D. Deeds, that said lands are free from incumbrances, that he will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.
