O. Dickinson, his heirs and assigns, all of my right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, situate in the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, to-wit:—

The West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Section West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14, Township 20, North, Range 13 East, To have and to hold unto the said W. O. Dickinson, his heirs, and administrators and assigns forever, with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging.
