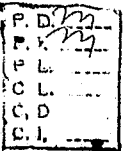

Warranty Deed.

With Relinquishment of Power.

Know all men by these Presents: That we Mary Kelly, now Mitchell
Jimson Chooley and Beckie Chooley, his wife, Daniel Barnett, Joanna Brown
and Lawina Kelly are single persons of said Territory for and in con-
sideration of Twenty-four Hundred Dollars, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and
convey unto Edward Crowell, of Tulsa, Indian Territory and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: South East quarter (S.E. 1/4) of South
West quarter (S.W. 1/4) and the north one half (N. 1/2) of the South West quarter (S.W. 1/4) of
Section 17, Township 19 North - Range 12 East, Creek Nation, Indian Territory,

to have and to hold the same unto the said Edward Crowell and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

and hereby covenant with said Edward Crowell that we will forever warrant
and defend the title of said lands against all persons claiming by, through,
in or under us.

And I, Beckie Chooley, wife of the said Jimson Chooley for and in
consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto
the said Edward Crowell all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said
lands.
