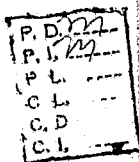

Warranted Deed, with Relinquishment of Powers.

Know all men by these Presents: That we Mary Kelly, now Mitchell, Jimison Chooley and Beckie Chooley, his wife, and Daniel Barnett, Joanna Brown and Powinia Kelly single persons of said Territory, for and in consideration of Eight Hundred Dollars do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Edward C. Crowell of Tulsa, Indian Territory and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The South West Quarter (S.W. 4) of the South West Quarter (S.W. 4) of Section 17 Township 19 North, Range 10 East, Creek Nation, being the homestead of Beckie Kelly, deceased.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Edward Crowell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Edward Crowell that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all persons claiming by, through or under us.

And I, Beckie Chooley, wife of the said Jimison Chooley, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Edward Crowell all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
