Deed of Release

Whereas, herebefore on Dec 14th 1905, J. D. Lee & A. J. Risinger of Lucas, Ind. Ter. executed a note for \$3500⁰⁰ payable to Henry Anderson at Farmers Natl Bank Lucas, Ind. Ter. on Dec. 14, 1906 and to secure the payment of said note said J. D. Lee and A. J. Risinger executed and delivered to Henry Anderson a chattel mortgage on certain Laundry machinery fixtures two horns wagons or fully described in said mortgage, which is recorded in Vol 4, Page 57 of the records of U.S. Court at Sapulpa, I. T. and the same parties on the same day executed a deed of trust on the same day to said Henry Anderson conveying the West 65 feet of Lot No 4 & the S 40 feet fronting on Denver Avenue by 65 feet deep of Lot No 5 in Block 69 in the City of Lucas, Ind. Risinger or their assigns all right title interest and claim that I have or in any and all property described in the above mentioned Chattel note or deed of Trust.
