The abutment, made and entered into the 2nd day of March, 1907, by and between the Midland Valley Railroad Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Arkansas, party of the first part, and C. Heywood, party of the second part, that the said party of the first part, for and on behalf of the sum of One Dollar, in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part the following described real estate situated in the Creek Nation and in the Indian District, Indian District, East:

A strip of land one hundred (100) feet in width and two thousand (2000) feet in length on the north side of, adjacent to and parallel with the Midland Valley right of way over and across the north half of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twelfth (12) East, being the same land as that owned by C. Heywood to the Midland Valley Railroad Company November 16, 1906, being that part of the land described in said deed as being granted lying on the north side of said right of way;

to have and to hold the aforementioned premises to the said C. Heywood and his heirs and assigns forever; and the said party of the first part, its successors and assigns, covenant with the said party of the second part, his heirs, successors and assigns, that it will and its successors and assigns shall, warrant and defend the same to the said party of the second part, and his heirs, successors and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, in whose behalf, the said party of the first part has or hereafter may become to be executed by its proper officers, shewings duly attested, and its corporate seal affixed, this 1st day and date first above written.
