

### Timber Contract

This agreement made and entered into this 27th day of April 1907 by and between Chapman Holakta and Lucy Holakta his wife parties of the first part favorably in consideration of the sum of Fifteen and no/100 <sup>dollars</sup> do hereby and by these presents let, lease and demise unto George F. Berryhill party of the second part all the timber, growing, standing and on the following described land to wit: - The North East Quarter of section 30 - Township 18 - North Range 13 - East, containing 160 acres.

The same being part of the allotments of the said parties of the first part.

Said party of the second part is to have the term of five years in which to remove the timber from said land.

The above consideration of Fifteen dollars to be paid as follows, to wit: - The sum of Fifteen dollars cash on signing this contract.
