You are hereby notified that this commission has appraised and scheduled to you property in the town of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, as follows:

Under the provisions of the Agreement with the Creek Nation as ratified by act of Congress, approved March 1, 1901, (31 Stat. 861), and by the National Council of the Creek Nation on May 25, 1901, you have the right to purchase the above described lots in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, at one-half of the appraised value thereof.

The first payment of ten (10) per centum of the amount due for each lot must be made within sixty days from the date of service of this notice. The second payment of fifteen (15) per centum additional within four months thereafter, and the remainder of the purchase money in three equal annual installments, the first annual installment becoming due and payable on Dec 6, 1903.

All of such payments must be made to the United States Indian Agent, Union Agency, Muskogee, Indian Territory.

If said payment of ten (10) per centum is not made within sixty days from the date of service of this notice, the property will be subject to sale at public auction to the highest bidder.
