Ray, be and remain her absolute individual property, and, on her death, shall pass to and rest in her heirs, assigns, distributees, devisees, administrators and executors forever, free and clear of any right, title, claim, interest or estate of him, the said Myron E. Hicks, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Ella P. Ray, in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars cash in hand paid to her by the said Myron E. Hicks, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, in consideration of the marriage to be hereafter contracted by her with the said Myron E. Hicks and in consideration of like covenants and agreements entered into with her by the said Myron E. Hicks and set out heretofore, doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Myron E. Hicks his heirs and assigns forever, that she, the said Ella P. Ray, shall never, by virtue of such marriage and as the living wife or surviving widow of the said Myron E. Hicks, have, acquire, assert or claim any right, title, interest or estate in any property of any kind which the said Myron E. Hicks shall own, have or possess at the time of the solemnization of the said proposed marriage or which the said Myron E. Hicks shall in any manner own or acquire during the continuance of the said marriage, either by way of homestead, dower, distributive share or in any other manner now or hereafter provided by law, but that all said property during the life of the said Myron E. Hicks, shall be and remain his absolute, individual property, to be used, enjoyed, bargained, sold, conveyed, devised and bequeathed by him at his own pleasure, and, on his death, shall pass to and rest in his heirs, assigns, distributees, devisees, administrators and executors forever, free and clear of any right, title, interest, estate or claim of her, the said Ella P. Ray, her heirs and assigns forever.

The object and purpose of this contract is to effect a full and complete relinquishment and release each to the other of any and all the property, rights or claims which either of the parties hereto waived or might have or acquire in the property of the other by virtue of said contemplated marriage and under any laws now in force or to be hereafter in force in the Indian Territory, in the State of Oklahoma, or in any other Territory, State or County in which the parties hereto or either of them may hereafter reside or acquire property.
