Bill of Sale.

Made and executed this the 22nd day of May, 1907, by and between Ewell Shipp of Muskogee, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and J. W. Shipp, of Springfield, Mo., party of the second part.

Now therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of nineteen hundred (\$1900.00) Dollars, cash in hand paid by the party of the second part to the party of the first part, herein, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part,

The party of the first part hereby sells, transfers and conveys to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns all of his right, title and interest in and right to the possession of the following described property, the title to which he guarantees, to-wit:

One spotted cow and calf branded B. L. on right hip and G on side; one black cow branded B. L. on right hip and one calf; one black two year old heifer, branded J. on right hip; one red yearling heifer; one roan heifer; one red steer calf; and about 60 head of hogs of different sizes, being all of the herd of hogs owned by the party of the first part, all of the said property being located on the Laura Doyle allotment of lands near Elder, I. T., all of said property being subject to a note, secured by mortgage on same, for \$460.62, dated Dec. 11th, 1906, in favor of the 1st National Bank of Muskogee, I. T.; and

One bay horse named Doc, situated on the above described land and subject to a note of \$250.00 secured by mortgage on same, due the 1st National Bank of Muskogee, I. T., and dated September, 19th, 1906; and

All lumber, cut and uncut, and lumber cut and uncut, located on the Laura Doyle allotment of lands, described as the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of T.M. 14 and E. 10 acres of lot 1 and South 20 acres of lot two and South 10 acres of lot three all of Section 15 and Township 17 N. and R. 14 East, and being sawed by Brown and Ebercase; and

all growing crops of corn and cotton for the year 1907 upon the allotment of David Grason, Pleasant Gray, Johnnie Sharpe
