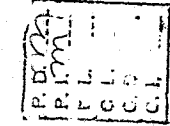

Lula, and Jerr. (Laced Natoni)
This agreement, entered into this 18th day of January, A.D. 1902, by and between E. M. Robinson and W. L. Rensen, parties of the first part, and Jay Forey the, party of the second part, sets forth the following:-

That in the building to be erected on the corner of Main and First street by the parties of the first part there shall be left on the south side of said building a space for a stairway of a width of four (4) feet and that there shall be left at the head of said stairway a space for landing five (5) feet in width and six (6) feet in length.

It is further agreed that the parties of the first part shall have a half interest in the north wall of the building owned by the party of the second part adjoining the property above described & belonging to the parties of the first part.

It is further agreed that the said stairway shall be built by the said party of the second part, and that, after the completion of said building to be erected by the parties of the first part the said stairway and landing shall be owned equally by the two parties hereto.
