Know All Men by these Presents; That We, Thomas Caesar and Fredie Caesar of the Creek Nation, have this day made, constituted and appointed Stewart & Stewart of Muskogee, Ind. Terr. Indian Territory, our lawful agents and attorneys in fact to act for us in our names, place and stead in the transaction of the following business; that is to say, to sell and transfer and sign affidavits and papers to the following described real estate; NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec 10, T 19 and Range 13 and SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 and Lot 5 of Sec 3 - T 19 and Range 13, and Lot 7 of Section 2 - T 19 & Range 12 East in the Indian Territory.

The said Thomas Caesar and Fredie Caesar hereby give and grant unto said Stewart & Stewart full power to sell and convey their undivided interest in the above described real estate for the sum of \$1,000. and to receive said sum and to sign all deeds and papers necessary for the conveying of the same; and said Stewart & Stewart are authorized to sign our names to any and all instruments of writing necessary to the consummation of the business aforesaid, and to do and perform any and all other acts and things necessary to the accomplishment of the same as we could lawfully do if personally present and acting, and we hereby ratify and confirm all that our said attorneys may lawfully do relative to the business aforesaid, and we hereby agree to pay my said attorney for his services in the performance of said business an amount equal to twenty per cent of the value of the property to be disposed of under this Power of attorney, all former Powers of attorney relative to said business so entrusted to our said agents are hereby revoked, and this Power of attorney is irrevocable.
