

their drilling operations, the party of the first part shall have the option to take over said oil well or wells at the actual cost that has been expended up to the time said well is found to be an oil well by the party of the second part; also it is understood and agreed that the party of the first part shall have the right to use on said premises all gas that may be necessary for his domestic purposes.

It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that this agreement, and lease and the conditions hereto shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns, and it is the intention of the party of the second part to use this lease in connection with its manufacturing plant, located in Sec 5-9-19-R-13.
