



Warranty Deed

Know all men by these presents; That we, William L. Gilcrease and Lizzie Gilcrease his wife, and James W. Antis and Ida B. Antis his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$150.00 One hundred fifty and no/100 Dollars, to us in hand paid by C. W. Heller of Muskogee, D. T. the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. W. Heller and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation - Western District of the Indian Territory, to and in the town of Wealok To-wit: all of lots number (2) Two in Block number nine (9) and lot number Two (2) in Block number Twenty five (25) according to the official Plat of said town on file in the 28th Recording District at Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. W. Heller and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And we hereby covenant with said C. W. Heller that we will forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie Gilcrease, wife of the said William L. Gilcrease and Ida B. Antis wife of the said James W. Antis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. W. Heller, all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
