Know All Men By These Presents, - That I, Susan M. Rogers of Muskogee, Ind. Ter., a widow for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand (\$3,000.00) ^{dollars} to me in hand paid by Dora Lieber of Muskogee, Ind. Ter. the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Dora Lieber and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation and Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, and the East half of the North-west quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section fifteen (15) T. 14 N. R. 12 E., the West half of North-west quarter of Southeast quarter of Section thirty-four (34) T. 12 N. R. 17 E. and the North half of South half of North-west quarter of Section three (3), T. 11 N. R. 17 E. of the Indian Jurisdiction containing 120 acres more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Dora Lieber and unto her heirs and assigns forever; with all appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging.

And I do hereby covenant with said Dora Lieber, that I will forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all claims what ever.
