Whereas, Ab. G. Perryman and Lucy Perryman, his wife, did on the 10th day of November, 1905 make an agricultural lease to C. A. Bowen upon the east one half (1/2) of the northwest quarter (1/4) and the southwest quarter (1/4) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of section twenty (20) and the east three quarters (3/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of the north east quarter (1/4) of section nineteen (19) all in township nineteen (19) north, range thirteen east.

And whereas, Ab. Perryman did on the 27th day of August, 1902 make an agricultural lease to the Bradley Realty Company on the said land, and

Whereas, Ab. Perryman did on the 10th day of September, 1905, make a timber deed to the International Land Company on the said land, and

Whereas, The International Land Company transferred by quit claim deed all right and interest in the said land to James Bowen on the 12th day of January, 1906, and

Whereas, The Bradley Realty Bank and Trust Company, formerly the Bradley Real Estate Company did on the 12th day of January, 1906 make a quit claim deed to C. A. Bowen on the said land.

Now therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in hand paid by C. C. Drew to James Bowen and C. A. Bowen, said James Bowen and C. A. Bowen hereby grant, bargain, sell transfer and assign and quit claim unto the said C. C. Drew all their right and title and interest in and to said land, from whatever source derived,
