Rental Contract

This Undertaking, made and entered into this 20th day of August, 1902, by and between Wille Ball, by Elly Ball, his father and guardian, and Wille Ball a child of the age of 8 years, citizen of the Creek or Muscogee Nation, party of the first part, and J. A. Friend, and J. M. Little, parties of the second part

Witnesseth: That, whereas the following described lands have been selected and by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes, set apart and allotted to the party of the first part, as his approximate share of the same of the Creek or Muscogee Nation, to wit, NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 19 N. Range 13 East

6. Said land is new and unimproved

and in consideration of the sum of cash paid during the term of this contract as hereinafter set forth to be paid by the party of the first part in the following manner, to wit, \$10.00 each

the above sets, \$22.00 Jan 1, 1903; \$22.00 Jan 1, 1904; \$22.00 Jan 1, 1905; \$22.00 Jan 1, 1906; and \$22.00 January 1, 1907; the receipt of \$10.00

in full of which in hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has the day and by the friends, willed, leased, devised, and retained the right and title of the second part, and into in assignor

and legal representatives, the land hereinafter described, to have and to hold said land from the first day of January 1908 months, until the first day of January, A.D. 1908.

It is further agreed that the parties of the second part shall, at his own expense, fence and keep the fences in repair around said premises, and make such other improvements as may be necessary for the better occupancy thereof during the continuance of the contract.
