

successors or assigns shall pay for all crops, orchards, buildings or other improvements on said premises that it may damage or destroy.

Said grantor shall have the privilege of selling said land or leasing the same for agricultural purposes, subject to the mineral interests therein hereby conveyed.

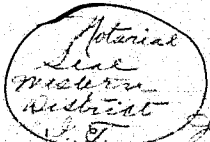
