the Osage Indian Reservation and of Oklahoma Territory party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Forty-seven Thousand Four hundred Fourteen & 27/100 the Dollar to them paid by E. M. Smith of Jackson County Missouri party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the purposes hereinafter expressed, have sold assigned and delivered and by these presents do sell assign and deliver unto said second party its successors and assigns all the following articles of personal property situated in the Creek Nation and of Indian Territory to-wit:

(1485) Fourteen Hundred and ^{eighty} Eight head of young Town and five year old steer cattle, being the identical cattle bought of U. S. Thompson of Beggs, Indian Territory on or about February first 1907, said cattle being branded T on right hip.

The above described cattle are now located in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, in pastures situate about five or six miles west of Broken Arrow - I. T. and there to be held until about March 1st 1907 at which time they are to be moved to pastures situate in the vicinity of Pawhuska O. T. Osage Nation and there to be held until this mortgage is fully satisfied.

Also included in this mortgage is sufficient feed, which is to be fed to the above described cattle in order to ^{keep} them in good thriving condition, and so fatten them out for market, together with all increase and addition thereto, whether by purchase or otherwise, all of which are specially included herein. Provided Always, and these presents, are upon these express conditions to-wit:

That said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid unto said party of the second part its successors or assigns:
