Whereas, The Secretary of the Interior and the Lessor of said lease have given their consent in writing to the assignment of said undivided one-fourth interest in said lease as is by the terms of said lease required,

Now Therefore, The party of the first part, for and in consideration of the premises and in consideration also, of the sum of one dollar in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further provisions of this contract, has sold, assigned and transferred and set over and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to and unto the party of the second part, his heirs, executors administrators and assigns all his right, title and interest in an undivided one-fourth interest in the following described oil and gas mining lease and the appurtenances thereto belonging to wit: -
