

containing eighty (80) more or less in the Cherokee Nation of the Indian Territory.

To Have and To Hold the said undivided one-fourth interest in said lease and in the leasehold estate created thereby to and unto the party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns for, and during the next residue and remainder of the Term of Fifteen years for which said lease is to run, the same to be held subject nevertheless to all rents, royalties, payments, covenants, conditions and stipulations in said lease contained, and subject moreover, to all such regulations as the Secretary of the Interior has lawfully made or may lawfully make, with regard to leasing of lands for oil and gas mining purposes from citizens of the Cherokee Nation.

It is further agreed and understood that this assignment shall be of no force or effect unless the party of the second part shall within sixty days from the date of the approval hereof furnish a certain bond in accordance with the regulations of March 20, 1905 prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, which bond shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of this assignment and the lease therein specifically referred to.
