


agree that the assignment of said undivided one-fourth interest in said lease shall be held by me subject in all respects to such rules and regulations as have been heretofore or may be hereafter prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior respecting leases for oil and gas mining purposes, executed by citizens of the Cherokee Nation.

And I further covenant and agree that said assignment shall be of no force or effect unless within sixty days from the approval of said assignment by the Secretary of the Interior, I shall furnish to the Secretary of the Interior a certain bond in accordance with the regulations of said Secretary of March 29, 1905; which bond shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of this assignment and said bond shall be a guarantee of the performance by me of the conditions of the lease hereinbefore specifically referred to so far as the same relates to the undivided one-fourth interest assigned to me. And I further covenant and agree that said assignment shall be of no force or effect until approved by the Secretary of the Interior
