Oil and Gas Mining Lease

Upon land selected for allotment, Cherokee Nation
Indian Territory. (Section 72 Act of July 1, 1902
32, Stat 716, 726).

This Indenture of Lease made and
entered into in quadruplicate on this 15th day
of February A.D. 1905 by and between John W. Archer
of Tulsa Indian Territory, party of the first part,
and Clinton B. Wiser and Percy D. McConnell, of
Bartlesville Indian Territory parties of the
second part, under and in pursuance of the
provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress,
approved July 1, 1902 and the regulations pre-
scribed by the Secretary of the Interior there-
under.

Witnesseth, That the party of the first part
for and in consideration of the covenants, conditions,
stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained
and agreed to be paid, observed and performed
by the parties of the second part, their heirs,
executors administrators and assigns do hereby
devise, grant and let unto the parties of
the second part their heirs, executors administ-
rators and assigns for the term of fifteen years from
the date hereof, all of the oil, deposits, and
natural gas in or under the following des-
cribed tract of land lying and being within the
Cherokee Nation, and within the Indian
Territory to wit: — E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E $\frac{1}{4}$: the E.
20 Acres of lot 7, and all of Lot 8 of Section
Twenty-three (23) township (20) north range
twelve (12) east, of the Indian meridian and con-
taining One Hundred Twenty-nine and $\frac{8}{100}$ (129.80)
acres, more or less, with the right to prospect
for, extract, pipe, store, refine and remove
such oil and natural gas and to occupy and
use so much only of the surface of said —
