

I now all men by these Presents, that I Clinton B. Wiser of the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory, formerly of Chicago Illinois, in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, transferred assigned set over and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the Cincos Oil Company, a corporation organized, existing and doing business under the laws of the State of West Virginia, its successors and assigns, to its and their proper uses and benefit, all of my undivided one half interest in and to a certain indenture of lease, bearing date the 15th day of February, 1905, made by John W. Archer a citizen of the Cherokee Nation and residing therein to me the said Clinton B. Wiser and Percy Don-Cornell: that is to say a certain oil and gas mining lease on the following described tract of land to-wit:-

C. 2 of the S. E. 4. E 20 of Lot 7: all of Lot 8 Section 2 3 Twp. 20, R. 12 E. containing 129.80 acres To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Cincos Oil Company its successors and assigns for and during all the rest residue and remainder of the term of years mentioned in the said indenture of lease, subject to all the conditions rules and regulations, prescribed and governing said lease and the conditions and provisions therein contained.
