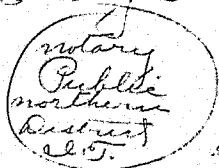

Wiser of the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory formerly of Chicago Illinois in consideration of one dollar, and other good and valuable considerations to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, transferred, assigned and set over, and by these presents do ^{hereby} sell assign transfer and set over unto the Cinco Oil Company, a corporation organized, existing and doing business under the laws of the State of West Virginia its successors and assigns, to its and their proper uses and benefit all of my undivided one-half interest in and to a certain indenture of lease bearing date the 28th day of February 1905 made by Thomas J. Archer (a minor) by John W. Archer Guardian, a citizen of the Cherokee Nation and residing therein, to me the said Clinton B. Wiser and Forry D. McConnell.
